- Course:** Math 40.1 0.5 unit 1.5 hours per week, or 25.5 hours per semester
- Text:** None
- Course Description:** Opportunity to develop additional competence in mathematics through supplemental instruction and supervised practice, either while enrolled in, or in preparation for a mathematics class. Assistance is provided for mathematics classes from arithmetic through beginning algebra.
- Learning Outcomes:** Demonstrate a greater command and understanding of student's mathematics subject area.
Have increased confidence in ability to learn mathematics.
Increase skills in writing and solving mathematics problems.
Improve ability to persevere in mathematics courses.
- Instruction and Practice:** Appropriate for self-controlled, self-motivated learners whose conduct does not infringe on the rights of others
Friendly atmosphere for individual and group instruction
Cooperative learning; opportunity for students working at different levels to share learning experiences
- Course Credit:** Student performance evaluated on **Pass/No Pass** basis only.
- Requirement for Credit:** **Pass** is earned when attendance is 70% or more (**17.85 hours or more**) during the semester.
No Pass is earned when attendance is less than 70% during the semester.
