Action/Discussion Items:

A. **Item: 20-087 – RVUSD Elementary and High School Tentative Reopening Plan**

Discussion: If Mendocino County remains within the “Red Tier” per the State’s COVID guidelines; schools will be able to reopen on a “modified” basis. Tentative reopening plans are being presented by both RVES and RVHS. Reopening plans must be reviewed and advised on by Dr. Coren, Mendocino County Public Health Officer and approved by the Board of Trustee’s prior to reopening.

Recommended Action: Review and approve the RVUSD Elementary and High School tentative reopening plans for the 2020-2021 School Year.

B. **Item: 20-088 –2020-2021 Every Student Succeeds Act Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI)**

Discussion: The RVHS CA Dashboard data identified RVHS for CSI based on suspension rates, focused specifically on Native American student suspensions. RVHS has determined that the focus of their CSI plan will be to improve school climate and culture. RVHS CSI was approved at the October Regular Board Meeting and submitted to Mendocino County Office of Education (MCOE) for review. MCOE required updates and changes to RVHS CSI. It has been updated and is presented to the Board for approval of the updates.
